

TEMPORARY TRAVEL DOCUMENT/LAISSEZ-PASSER REQUIREMENTS

This document is issued to a Liberian Citizen (who has lost an original passport) for emergency travel only.

- Applicant must show evidence of Liberian citizenship:
 - A photocopy of missing passport.
 - Original copy of Liberian Naturalization Certificate
- If copies of the documents are not readily available, the following must be submitted:
 - A notarized letter addressed to the Consular Section, stating how the original Passport went missing.
 - Three (3) notarized letters from Liberian citizens addressed to the Consular section testifying to the citizenship claim of the applicant, along with photocopies of the first five pages of their Liberian passoorts.
- 3. Two (2) passport size photographs:
 - 2 x 2 inches in size, in full colour and identical.
 - Taken within the past six (6) months, showing current appearance.
 - Full face, front view with a plain white or off-white background.
 - Between 1 inch and 1 3/8 inches from the bottom of the chin to the top of the head.
 - Taken in normal street attire. Uniforms should not be worn, only religious attire that is worn daily.
 - Do not wear a hat or headgear that
 - If prescription glasses, a hearing device, wig or similar article is normally worn, it should be worn for your picture.
 - Dark glasses or non-prescription glasses with tinted lenses are unacceptable unless needed for medical reasons. A medical certificate may be required.
- 4. A signed, completed application form.
- 5. Interview by the Consular Section.
