YALI was created in 2010 and supports young Africans as they spur economic growth and prosperity, strengthen democratic governance, and enhance peace and security across Africa. Since 2014, many young leaders from every country in Sub-Saharan Africa have participated in the Mandela Washington Fellowship.
