

## Washington D.C., April 14, 2025

— In a move poised to further strengthen the enduring ties between Liberia and the United States, His Excellency the Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Liberia to the United States, Dr. Al-Hassan Conteh, arrived at Dulles International Airport in Virginia on a brisk Monday.
